

# July 4<sup>th</sup> is Family Day at Camp Kingfisher!

All details are subject to change

- On July 4<sup>th</sup> you may:
  - Drop off your camper at 9:00 for a regular day of camp
    - You and your family may join your camper at any point during the day
  - Choose not to come to camp at all (we hope you don't choose this ☺)
  - Arrive at camp with your whole gang (at any time between 9:00am and 3:00pm)
  - Once a camper joins his or her family, he/she cannot return to a camper group. You will remain responsible for your camper(s) until you depart
- We will connect with you via email to ask you a few simple questions:
  - Do you plan on attending camp on July 4<sup>th</sup>?
  - If so, do you plan on dropping off your camper or arriving as a family?
  - If you are arriving as a family, how many guests do you expect to bring?
- When you arrive on July 4<sup>th</sup> (at any time) there will be a welcome table in the gym to help you get oriented
  - If you arrive later than your camper(s), we will help you locate them
  - You will receive a schedule for the day and a map of the grounds
  - You will have the opportunity to sign up for canoeing (this activity fills up fast, so come early if you want to canoe)
  - You will have the opportunity to purchase Camp K merchandise

  - Hang out and swim at the POOL!!
  - Canoe at Beaver or Heron Pond\*
  - Make something in Arts and Crafts
  - Enjoy the trails
  - Play on the field – organized games and face painting all day
- 2:30 – 3:00 Large Raptor Demo – Great Horned Owl – in the gym
- 3:00 Goodbye – see your campers tomorrow!
