## School Programs 2011-2012

### Onsite Programs

All programs occurring onsite at the Chattahoochee Nature Center are a 2 hour and 30 minute experience. Each program includes a guided forest hike, an up-close animal encounter with one of our non-releasable wildlife, use of the Nature Center grounds (including picnic areas, gardens and the aviaries), and 30 minutes in our new Discovery Center! The following programs are GPS correlated for each grade!

Program times are from 9:45-12:15 or 10:00-12:30 unless otherwise noted and include time for lunch.

## Outreach Programs

Gas prices got you down? Not a problem! CNC naturalists can bring the same high-quality programming directly into your classroom. We even offer large group programs designed for an auditorium setting! All programs are GPS correlated for each grade.

## Classroom Programs

All of our **Onsite Programs** can be conducted at your school in individual classrooms, and still include an animal encounter and hands-on activities. See Onsite Programs, above.

### *The Five Part Series*

This 3rd grade program includes five one-hour visits from the CNC to your classroom over the course of the school year. Each class includes a hands-on activity and an animal encounter. Students receive their own journal to use throughout the program and includes pre- and post-visit activities. Classes include: *Under Your Feet, Nature's Neighborhoods, Skull Study, Georgia Habitats, and Pollution Solutions.*

## Auditorium Programs

### *Grades K – 12<sup>th</sup>: Hunters in the Sky*

Raptors are one of our most fascinating native predators. This program compares and contrasts a hawk and owl. Utilizing audience involvement and live animals, this program teaches students about these birds' impressive abilities.



#### *Grades K-12<sup>th</sup>: Owl Wise*

Get up close and personal with Georgia's native nocturnal raptors. CNC naturalists bring three species of owls to you and teach about the unique adaptations and life histories of this amazing group of raptors.



#### *Grades K-12<sup>th</sup>: Hawk Squawk*

Who's that soaring above your head? Learn about the diverse diurnal raptors that inhabit Georgia. CNC naturalists bring along three native hawk species and teach about their cool characteristics.

### *Grades K – 12<sup>th</sup>: Georgia Wildlife Journey*

What lives in your own backyard? This program allows students to learn about three animals native to the Piedmont region of Georgia. Meet a mammal, reptile, and bird of prey: quite a memorable team of animal ambassadors!
