

The Nature Exchange at the Chattahoochee Nature Center Presents The Sixth Annual "Double Vision for Kids" Contest



General Information

Every year at this time the Nature Center has its Double Vision display hanging in the Discovery Center's upstairs gallery. There you will see beautiful photos taken by Georgia Nature Photographers Association members and interpretive paintings of those photos by the Roswell Fine Arts Alliance members.

The CNC Nature Exchange staff is always looking for ways to connect with young nature enthusiasts so in 2020 we held our First Annual Double Vision for Kids Contest. We would like to invite you to participate in our Sixth Annual Double Vision for Kids Contest.

The contest starts Monday, September 1^{st} and will run through Sunday, November 30th, 2025. It is open to kids in three categories: $K - 2^{nd}$ Grade, $3^{rd} - 5^{th}$ Grade and $6^{th} - 8^{th}$ Grade. You do not need to be a CNC member or a registered CNC Nature Exchange trader to enter this contest.

To participate, take your own photo with a camera or phone of something cool out in the natural world. It can be a photo of animals, plants, fungi, a landscape scene, rocks, sky – anything in nature. Please use your own photo – DO NOT use a photo from the internet or cut one from a magazine because we will also be judging and giving an award for the Best Photo.

Next, create your own artistic interpretation of that photo. (To interpret means to show or explain what something means to you and everyone's interpretation is unique.) Participants can use any materials or medium they choose. We encourage you to use as many materials as you would like. Also, please make sure to give your work of art a title.

We will award CNC Nature Exchange Points for First, Second and Third Place Winners in each category. Winners that are not CNC Nature Exchange traders will have a new trader account set up in their name. Awards will be as follows:

First Place: 5000 Points Second Place: 2500 Points Third Place: 1000 Points

All entries must be received no later than Sunday, November 30 at 5PM. The winners will be posted on Saturday, December 6, 2025 and will be announced on the CNC Website. All winners will receive a personal email as well.

All entries will be displayed down in the Nature Exchange through Tuesday, December 30, 2025. Along with their entry, only the participant's first name with last initial, grade, title of art and medium will be displayed. Participants can pick up their photos and art from January 2-31, 2026.

Fill out the entry form and include it along with your original artwork and a copy of your photo. Copies of photos do not need to be on photography paper – just a colored print on regular copy paper is fine.
